A meeting of the Fortune Town Council took place on Thursday, March 14, 2002 at 7:30 p.m. In attendance was Mayor Penwell, Deputy Mayor Alec Noseworthy, Councillors Derrick Reid, Harvey Tulk and Kim Price. Also in attendance was Mr. Earl Rose, Mr. Lloyd Price and Mr. Samuel Cumby of the Harbour Authority of Fortune.

Members of the Harbour Authority were welcomed by Mayor Penwell. Mr. Rose informed Council \$23,000.00 had been approved by the Dept. of Industry, Trade and Rural Development to do an engineering study on the development of the western side of the harbour.

Mr. Rose informed Council they would have to call for proposals or tender the work with at least five engineering companies. The Harbour Authority requested the help of Council's staff in preparing the documents which Council gave approval. Some discussion arose over the following:

- 1) statistics about the increase in the number of vessels using the harbour in years 2000 and 2001.
- 2) the tariff of 25% on shrimp dropped on January 1, 2002, that is being transhipped through St. Pierre to the European Common Market.
- 3) plans for a conference to be held in Fortune involving Burin Peninsula Businesses, St. Pierre, Provincial & Federal Governments about issues and business opportunities connected with St. Pierre.

**Be It Resolved:** It was moved by councillor Reid and seconded by Councillor Tulk the agenda be adopted as read. Motion unanimously carried.
