A regular meeting of the Fortune Town Council was held on October 23, 1989 at 7:00 pm.

Members present were: Mayor King, Deputy Mayor Piercey, Councillors Piercey, Penwell, Cooper, King & Collier.

Items arising from Minutes:

- (1) Arena Clock: Neither Company is prepared to supply a new clock because of the low volume of sales, however Pepsi is negotiating with Lloyd Hines for a maintenance contract on our clock.
- (2) The Town Manager in consultation with the Town Manager of Grand Bank has agreed that the Ambulance Driver's payroll be done at this office.
- (3) It was moved by Councillor Collier, seconded by Councillor Piercey that we accept the recommendation of NewPlan Consultants to re allocate the funds from Piercey & Community Street to the paving of Bunkerhill Road and part of Haddock Road due to the problems experienced on Piercey Street.
- (4) Road repairs on Piercey Street near Charlie Bungay's and Charles Pierce's property has been completed with a wooden structure-not enough space to erect concrete wall. It was moved by Councillor Collier, seconded by Councillor Piercey the minutes be approved as presented. Motion carried.

Items Town Manager's File:

- (1) Permission for Babb's Construction to obtain armoured stone from Dam Road. It was agreed that an affidavit be signed to resurface the road, restore the area and comply with all blasting regulations. Also no more pits to be opened on the Harbour Access Road.
- (2) Re sale of land-Benson Street. It was agreed to have Earl check out the type of land to determine its value.
- (3) It was moved by Deputy Mayor Piercey, seconded by Councillor Cooper that the expense report for the Fire Chiefs trip to St. John's re Lake Academy and Senior Citizens Cottages, be approved. Motion carried.

- (4) Letter from Mr. Robert Dicks-Dept. of Highways quoting measured distance from Lake Academy to Aubrey Hillier's via Bayview Street 2.1 km=1.3 miles and via Confederation Street, Logwood Road, Springhill Road 2.3 km=1.4 miles. Council requested the measurements from Riverside East to schools at Grand Bank.
- (5) Letter from Mrs. Andrea Stuckey re donation to new Brownie Pack. It was moved by Councillor Pnewell, seconded by Councillor Piercey that we donate \$100.00 to this group. Motion carried.
- (6) Re: Fresh Water System to plant. It was agreed that if no information is received from the Dept. of Municipal Affairs within the next few days, the Town Manager will arrange meeting for a delegation to St. John's.
- (7) A paper re management & operations of Regional Solid Waste Disposal Site was distributed to Council. It was agreed to study same and discuss at next meeting.
- (8) Councillor Cooper suggested we write the fire department acknowledging their efforts and activities during Fire Prevention Week. Agreed.
- (9) Councillor Penwell requested that we provide an hour of free skating for Lake Academy students that will be participating in the recycling of pop cans, bottles, etc program. It was agreed. Also write to Mr. Eric George advising him of Councils decision and request that he advise us of day and time for same.

Re permit applications-Lloyd Barnes to erect residence on Bunkerhill Road. It was moved by Councillor King, seconded by Councillor Piercey that application be approved pending the signing of an affidavit that should any problems occur in the future with regards to land of Hughie Savoury and Charles Bobbett, that he would be responsible for such repairs etc that would be necessary. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councillor Piercey, seconded by Councillor Penwell that application be approved for Councillor King for extension to shed on the farm. Motion carried.


