A regular meeting of the Fortune Town Council was held on Monday October 15, 1990 at 7:00 pm.

Members present were Mayor Penwell, Deputy Mayor King, Councillors Thornhill, Warren and Cooper.

## Items arising from Minutes

- (1) No reply from correspondence to Fire Commissioners Office.
- (2) Nothing further re Funeral Home-officials will be in Town within the next couple of weeks to see Town Manager.
- (3) Cinco engineers arrived today to complete work at the Arena.
- (4) New Fire Truck-problem with gear box seems to be corrected.
- (5) Sign for Canadian Coast Guard has been reviewed and approved by the permit committee-letter sent to Coast Guard re approval
- (6) Neighbourhood Watch-contacted Al Conrod to get groups together sometime soon.

It was moved by Councillor Warren, seconded by Deputy Mayor King the minutes be approved as presented. Motion carried.

## Agenda:

- (1) Letter from Burin Peninsula School Board in reply to our correspondence -they are not in a financial position to install burglar alarm system at the schools at this time.
- (2) Deputy Mayor King gave a report on the Solid Waste Disposal Committee meeting held on September 26th. Recommendations as put forth by our committee were acceptable with the exception of # 11 " that the site be administered by committee with equal representation from both Towns'. Grand Bank Committee recommended having an extra person from the administering Town and that the Committee be incorporated. It was agreed Council will adhere to its original position re the committee and does not see the need for incorporation.

Town Managers from Fortune & Grand Bank & Mr. Mills of NewPlan Consultants met with Weir Construction re Phase II Road & Site Development. There appears to be some question as to the amount of bog to be removed, however New Plan working on same.


