A regular meeting of the Fortune Town Council was held on Monday July 16, 1990 at 4:00 pm. Members present were: Deputy Mayor King, Councillor King, Collier and Warren.

Items arising from previous minutes:

1. Town Manager reported that Bill Mills of NewPlan Consultants had estimated roughly \$160,000.00 to correct the problem of water on Eldon Street.
2. Corwin Marks has not yet signed the affidavit.
3. Some discussion re Business Permit applications must comply with all regulatory departments-it was decided to hold for further discussion when a full Council is in attendance.
4. Dept. of Transportation is now painting crosswalks, road lines, etc.
5. Section 25 Project-Senior Citizens area beautification now in progress-Salt house project to begin August 6th.
6. Capping dyke-Town Manager has had discussion with Engineers re same.

Correction from previous minutes-Councillor Warren gave a report on the Community Futures meeting and Mayor Penwell informed Council that Mr. Harold Lake is no longer a representative with the Burin Peninsula Tourism Association and a new member is needed.

It was moved by Councillor Collier, seconded by Councillor King the minutes be approved as presented. Motion carried.

General Business:

1. It was moved by Councillor King, seconded by Councillor Collier that we lease a portion of Horse Brook Trailer Park to Mr. Gary Stapleton to set up a Mini Golf Course until Labour Day Weekend for the amount of \$300.00. Motion carried.
2. Re Five Year Capital Works Program. It was agreed to follow same procedure as in previous years.
3. Scallop Industry-rumors re Council-no correspondence what so ever from Mr. Parsons except verbal contact with Town Clerk.
4. Deputy Mayor King advised Council that the Fortune Harbour Authority is making an effort to have the Small Craft Harbour dredged while the equipment is here.

5. Water Shed-Clean out and construct holding basin-pending decision of NewPlan Consultants.
6. It was agreed to have the Come Home Year Logo put on the next order of Town Stationery.

Correspondence:

1. Dept. of Health-acknowledgement of our correspondence.
2. Neighbourhood Watch-Zone 4 Herbert Stuckey-Captain. Suggesting better lighting in the area of the Arena to help prevent vandalism. It was agreed to investigate the cost of street lighting for the area-also put up Chain Link fence to prevent vehicles from getting to the back of the Arena.
3. Tax Update-Health & Post Secondary Education Tax-Councils are exempt.
4. Burin Peninsula Community Futures Committee-outlining progress to date and request for Council to re-imburse members for loss wages etc. It was agreed to defer until Councillor Warren attends the next meeting and gets further information on the issue.
5. Letter Mr. Clem Benteau-It was moved by Councillor King, seconded by Councillor Collier that Mr. Benteau be given permission to stop his Meals on Wheels Vehicle at the park and that he be charged a \$25.00 business permit and we make an effort to find out what other Town's charge for this type of business. Motion carried.
