A meeting of the Fortune Town Council was held on May 17, 1993 with the following in attendance: Mayor Penwell, Deputy Mayor King, Councillors Reid, Warren, King Cooper, Thornhill.

Work Superintendent-Earl Rose attended the opening of meeting re the problem with Jordon Thornhill's sewer. It is joined on Charles Thornhill's sewer and he replaced his sewer last year. There is no sewer on Pinchmarsh Road. He wanted some direction if the sewer is collapsed. It was agreed it would not be Council's responsibility.

It was moved by Councillor Thornhill and seconded by Deputy Mayor King the minutes of the regular meeting April 27, 1993 and the minutes of the Budget meeting May 4, 1993 be adopted as read.

Water problem on Lafosse's Lane. It was agreed we would (1) find out where the sewer is (2) see if the householders would be responsible for connecting from their houses to the stand pipes.

Request from Mr. Melvin Thornhill-It was moved by Deputy Mayor King and seconded by Councillor Cooper, we would sell to Melvin Thornhill at the prime rate and if Tom Douglas still needs the jib, but this would be the final land on Haddon Grounds for sale. Motion carried.
