A regular meeting of the Fortune Town Council was held February 15, 1993 at 7:00 pm. The following members were present: Mayor Penwell, Deputy Mayor King, Councillors Reid, King, Thornhill, Cooper and Warren.

It was moved by Councillor King and seconded by Councillor Cooper the minutes of the January 26, 1993 regular meeting be adopted as read. Motion carried.

General:

- (1) Report on meeting with Victor Young of F.P.I. Ltd by Mayor Penwell. Plant is not expected to open until June or July for approximately 14 weeks if they get enough flounder. Future is not be bright for the next three or four years. Mentioned he would like to see our tax agreement settled.
- (2) Waste Disposal Committee meeting scheduled for Wednesday February 17, 1993:

 - (2) User Fee-Town of Burin

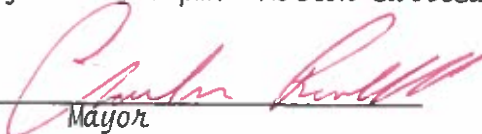
