A regular meeting of the Fortune Town Council was held on Monday November 6, 1989 at 7:00 pm. Members present were: Mayor King, Deputy Mayor Piercey, Councillors Piercey, King, Collier, Cooper and Penwell.

Items arising from Minutes:

- (1) Fresh Water System-Town Manager reported that he had talked with Mr. Keith Warren who was checking out the issue and would get back to him as soon as possible.
- (2) Re land-Benson Street. The works superintendent reported that he had done test holes on the land which Mr. Aubrey Freeborn has requested to purchase. The test holes show 25 feet from road line 2-3 feet of bog-60ft. 4-7ft. of bog. After some discussion it was suggested we ask Mr. Freeborn to make us an offer on the land then discuss it at a later date.
- (3) Some discussion re the destruction on the hill opposite the harbour by Babbs Construction. It was moved by Councillor Penwell, seconded by Councillor Piercey that Babb's Construction be notified in writing that they are not allowed to continue moving their equipment up and down the hill. If it continues their permit to remove armour stone from that area will be revoked. Motion carried.
- (4) Re Committee proposal-Waste Disposal Site. It was decided to defer for a while.
- (5) Town Manager checked with Mr. Bob Dicks to get mileage from Bus Stops at Grand Bank. He will check with his supervisor and get it done as soon as possible.

It was moved by Deputy Mayor Piercey, seconded by Councillor Cooper the minutes be adopted as presented. Motion carried.

Items Town Manager's File:

- (1) Inspection reports received from Lake Academy and Fortune Collegiate



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- (2) It was moved by Councillor Penwell, seconded by Councillor King that we sponsor a full page in the Fortune Collegiate year book at a cost of \$50.00. Motion carried.
- (3) Letter from Peter Mews re cutting off 2 feet of the curb to widen driveway. It was moved by Councillor Pirecey, seconded by Councillor Penwell that we cannot cut the curb. Motion carried.
- (4) Letter from Alfred Bonnell re operating an ambulance service for our Town. It was decided to notify Mr. Bonnell that our ambulance service from Fortune and Grand Bank will continue to be operated by the ambulance committee.
- (5) It was agreed that we would allow the Fortune Senior Hockey Team 1 hour free practice per week and other arrangements as in previous years.
- (6) Letters of information re Job Development Program, Argentia Ferry Service and Cystic Fibrosis.
- (7) The Town Manager requested some one to bring greetings from the Town at the Memorial Day Service at Fortune Collegiate on Wednesday at 10:30 am.
- (8) It was agreed to have a meeting on Wednesday November 15, 1989 at 7:00 pm for swearing in of new Council.

It was moved by Deputy Mayor Piercey, seconded by Councillor Penwell that the Town Manager be authorized to submit an application for landscaping etc in the area of the Senior Citizens Housing Units.

Permit applications were presented for: Gilbert Bonnell-Haddock Rd.-Erect Garage
John Martin-Ceko Place-Erect Shed

It was moved by Councillor Piercey, seconded by Councillor Penwell the permits be approved as presented. Motion carried.

Councillor King reported that the Harbour Authority will be holding its annual meeting on November 7, 1989.

The Lions Club requested permission to erect signs at each end of town. Agreed.
